We look forward to welcoming you to our annual Portland Law School Fair.

WHEN AND WHERE

The fair will be held on SATURDAY, November 1, 2025, from 10:00am-1:00pm, in the Smith Memorial Center Ballroom on the Portland State University campus in downtown Portland. PLEASE ENTER THE BUILDING FROM BROADWAY AS THOSE ARE THE ONLY DOORS THAT WILL BE OPEN TO THE PUBLIC.

We advertise the event with student organizations throughout Oregon and southern Washington, and you can expect to meet students from Portland State University, Oregon State University, Reed College, the University of Portland, Western Oregon University, Lewis and Clark College, Willamette University, George Fox University, Pacific University, Washington State University-Vancouver, and many other institutions throughout the Pacific Northwest.

ARRIVAL

Transportation from Portland International Airport (PDX): PDX is located 9 miles east of downtown and is served by most domestic airlines. One way to get in from the airport to a downtown hotel is by the Tri-Met MAX light rail service, which takes about forty-five minutes to an hour. For schedules and information, check <u>www.trimet.org</u>. The airport station is located right outside of the terminal. Taxis and rideshare services are easily accessible at the airport, and some local hotels offer their own shuttle service. The major rental car agencies have offices at the airport.

Locating the PSU Campus

If you must drive, be sure to allow time for parking.

Nearby lunch options (all within an easy five-minute walk):

Portland Farmers Market- right outside of Smith Hall with a large number of prepared food vendors

Food cart pod on 4th and Hall- lots of variety and options of cuisine at affordable prices, though not all are open on Saturday

Tasty Corner- Szechuan spot known for their orange chicken and fried rice, corner of Hall and 6th
